Dear Resident

I hope that you are settling in to Drumoig and on behalf of our Drumoig Residents Association, I welcome you to the area. The booklet contains information about our activities and benefits of membership. I would invite and encourage you to join and support your residents Association which has over 94% of Drumoig households as members.

Drumoig Residents Association (DRA) represents member households at Drumoig and has the following aims and objectives.

- 1. To protect and advance the interests of all house owners and residents in the area covered by the Association on matters concerning the environment and the social and community life of the area.
- 2. The Association is non-political.
- 3. The Association may liaise or co-operate with other local organisations that share these aims and objectives.

We work to provide benefits to householders by using our pooled resources and house maintenance experiences to negotiate better terms for matters affecting utilities and house maintenance information. We also monitor local planning developments which may be applicable to the Drumoig area.

Finally we hold various social activities throughout the year to promote social interaction between members, and we also keep our members informed of local events organised by members or other local organisations.

Some of our activities are outlined later but include:

- Website provides news and information for residents on local developments and services; useful links; articles by local residents; information on upcoming events, etc.
- Email updates we communicate primarily by email to keep members informed of recent news
- Wildlife Forum we hold meetings and events to promote the wildlife habitat around Drumoig.
- Rambling Group
- Book Club
- Bridge Club
- Mah-Jong Club
- Annual General Meeting a review of the year's business and appointment of the next year's committee.

I do hope you will support the Drumoig Residents Association by joining us, and hope you will also support the various functions and events that we hold throughout the year.

LPG Contract Information:

You will be aware that the houses in Drumoig are not on mains gas and many use LPG as an important source of fuel. In Comerton and Forgan all houses have individual LPG tanks. In Craigie there is a common tank which supplies LPG to houses via underground pipes and gas meters.

In Forgan and Comerton the individual household is contracted to a supplier. You may be asked by a LPG supplier to sign a new contract when you move in to the house.

We would advise you not to sign until you have checked the position with the DRA.

Contracts are for 2-year periods and we have, for many years, negotiated favourable terms for our members. These terms are not automatically applied by the LPG Supplier.

Residents in Craigie have ALL signed an agreement that authorises the DRA to negotiate on behalf of all the residents, and there is a collective agreement in place to cover the supply of LPG to these houses. If you have moved into Craigie Hill, please contact John Cuthbertson or the Secretary or any other Committee member to get more details of these schemes.

When you join the DRA we will provide information on the current member's rate and contract timing.

Drumoig Wildlife

There is a great variety of wildlife in and around Drumoig. Red squirrels, deer, pheasants, rabbits, toads and other mammals are often spotted by residents. There is also habitat for a variety of birds. As well as numerous types of garden birds, we also have birds of prey, water birds on the ponds, and ground nesting birds including the protected skylark. We ask that residents help preserve the habitat particularly of ground nesting birds by only walking on recognised paths and by keeping any pets under strict control. Wood Burning Stoves:

If you have a wood-burning stove, we can provide information on a local supplier of kiln-dried hardwood logs. We have negotiated a favourable price for our members for bulk delivery of crates and bags of logs. Details are on our website.
